1-Day Emergency First Aid at Work

Description

The course aims to teach delegates basic aspects of dealing with emergencies, with an emphasis on handling 'life threatening' situations in the workplace.

Objectives

On completion of the course, successful candidates should be able to:

- + understand the role of the Emergency First Aid at Work first aider, including reference to:
 - the importance of preventing cross infection;
 - the need for recording incidents and actions;
 - use of available equipment;
- + assess the situation and circumstances in order to act safely, promptly and effectively in an emergency;
- + administer first aid to a casualty who is unconscious (including seizure);
- + administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation;
- + administer first aid to a casualty who is choking;
- + administer first aid to a casualty who is wounded and bleeding;
- + administer first aid to a casualty who is suffering from shock;
- + provide appropriate first aid for minor injuries.

Prerequisites

Suitability

The course is ideal for people who do not require a fully certificated first aid qualification but who feel that a basic knowledge in the subject would be useful to their role.

Qualification

On completion of the course, delegates will receive an 'Emergency First Aid at Work' certificate which is valid for three years.
